#### Resolution GA2019.2-2:

#### 4.2 Periodic evaluation of the Hungarian Partner Facility

## Resolution GA2019.2-3:

The General Assembly welcomes the ISTAC positive evaluation of the Hungarian Partner Facility and supports the continuation of its operation within CERIC-ERIC. The General Assembly takes note of the recommendations and supports their implementation.

#### 4.3 Evaluation of the proposal for a Serbian Partner Facility

#### Resolution GA2019.2-4:

The General Assembly, considering its resolution GA2017.2-10, which discussed the temporary participation of the FAMA (FAcility for Modification and Analysis of materials with ion beams) facility of the Vinča Institute of Nuclear Sciences of Belgrade in the CERIC-ERIC calls, and the recent evaluation of the ISTAC assessing the lack of conditions to admit the above facility as CERIC-ERIC Partner Facility, agrees that the ISTAC shall reconsider the evaluation of the FAMA facility as official Serbian Partner Facility in CERIC-ERIC in one year time, if the requirements presented in the report of Vinča Institute and the ones raised by the ISTAC at the time of evaluation in 2017 will be met.





#### 4.4 Proposal for a new ISTAC member

#### Resolution GA2019.2-5:

The General Assembly, taking into account the term of reference of the International Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee (ISTAC) and the proposal of the Chair of the ISTAC, appoints prof. Christoph Quitmann as new member of the ISTAC for a term of three years.
