Objectives

Structure

- A first session of presentations focused on assessing the current state of employment management within ERICs, based on a comprehensive analysis of the data collected so far and the presentation of relevant case studies.
- A second session with a brief overview of the work of the EC on Research Careers and a dynamic round table discussion with EC policy officers and external legal experts.

The insights and recommendations emerging from this workshop should pave the way for the development of a reference employment treatment that meets the evolving needs of European research infrastructures.
